

Important notes for all candidates

1. Candidates who have passed the course should make clearance for graduation. The clearance form can be picked at LDC reception. The deadline for clearance is 20th April, 2018.
2. Graduation fee is **250,000= inclusive of graduation, transcript and Diploma certificate**

Such appeals shall be addressed to the Secretary Appeals Committee and submitted by **not later than 9th April, 2018 at 5.00p.m. Please attach evidence of payment for the appeal.**
5. Candidates who have been discontinued from the course should collect their letters of discontinuation on 28th March, 2018. The letters will be collected from the office of the undersigned.
6. Candidates required to repeat failed subjects should collect their letters on 26th March, 2018. The letters will be collected from the office of the undersigned.
