

Important Notes to all Participants

- Candidates who have passed the course should pay 200,000/=. This fee is divided as follows: Transcript and certificate (shs.100,000), Graduation ceremony (shs.80,000), certification of two copies (20,000). The money should be deposited on the LDC bank account either in the Centenary Bank or United Bank of Africa using LDC students fees deposit slips. The account numbers are indicated on the LDC deposit slips to be issued by the course coordinator.
- The date for the Graduation ceremony will be announced in due course. Successful participants who would wish to have provisional transcripts should contact the office of the undersigned. Provisional transcripts shall be issued to only successful participants who have paid fully the requisite fee (shs. 200,000).
- Certificates and transcripts will be issued on the day of graduation.
- Please note that the Academic Registrar's office does not issue transcripts and certificates to anyone other than the participant.
- The special and supplementary examinations will be held in **September, 2018** with the students of the **August/September, 2018 Day programme**.
- The Department of Law and Continuing Legal Education will provide the time table for the examinations.
- You will be required to pay Shs. **50,000=** per subject for the special/supplementary examinations.
