Call for Applications to Enrol on Various Courses

The Academic Registrar Law Development Centre invites applications for admission to various courses as indicated below:

1. Bar Course, 2021/2022 Academic Year (2nd intake)

The Bar Course shall be conducted at LDC Lira campus through online and/or physical learning. The course will commence on **7th February, 2022.**

Eligibility

To be eligible for admission to the Bar Course, the applicant should be:

- a) A holder of a degree in law granted by a University in Uganda whose law programme has been accredited by the Law Council.
 - i. This applies to Ugandan and non-Ugandan citizens.
 - ii. The degree must have been obtained from a university or institution of higher education duly licensed or chartered under the laws of Uganda and accredited by the Law Council.
- b) A citizen of Uganda who is a holder of a degree in law obtained from a University or institution in a foreign country operating the common law system and recognized by the Law Council of Uganda. The applicant must obtain prior clearance in writing from the Law Council.
- c) A former Bar Course student intending to repeat the entire Bar Course or subject(s) as provided for by the applicable Rules for Governing the Bar Course.

How to apply

Interested applicants may apply online via the link: <https://admissions ldc.ac.ug/>. The link will prompt you to fill in the required information and make payment online before submission of the application.

Note

- a) Law faculties should submit lists of successful LLB candidates by 14th January 2022. The students should be listed/ranked in order of performance from best downwards.
- b) Only applicants willing and able to undertake a blend of online and physical learning should apply for admission.
- c) Current undergraduate students who have not yet completed their degree programmes are ineligible to apply for admission.
- d) Applicants must provide evidence of full vaccination for covid-19

Deadline for application

Applications should be submitted not later than **31st December, 2021**.

2. Diploma in Law Course (Weekend only to be taught at Kampala, Lira & Mbarara campuses)

The Diploma in Law Course will commence on **8th January 2022**.

3. Diploma in Human Rights Course (Evening only to be taught at Kila, Lira & Mbarara campuses)

The course will commence on **10th January 2022**.

Requirements for admission to the Diploma Courses

1. Applicants should have a minimum of 'O' level (UCE) with five passes obtained at the same sitting plus a Principal Pass and two subsidiary passes at 'A' Level obtained at the same sitting.
2. Applicants must provide evidence of full vaccination for covid-19


How to Apply for Diploma Courses
